COMMITTEE REPORTS

July 1, 2017-June 30, 2018

Election Committee

The committee has worked hard this year to increase voter turnout and prepare for the 2018 WVAGP Board of Directors election. In regards to increasing voter turnout, the committee used data from Jennings Starcher (past Chair) to approach voter turnout, the first step was to create a white paper of what similar geospatial organizations do for voting and elections in other states, the second was to talk to WVAGP founding and current board members about the election rules to be able to try new approaches to increase voter turnout. This information will be presented at the 2018 WVAGP conference for the consideration of members to determine next steps.

At the 2018 WVAGP elections, we have 12 qualified candidates for the six seats that are available. There are four candidates representing the state constituency, none representing the education and research constituency, four candidates representing the regional/local government constituency and two candidates representing the private sector constituency, and one candidate representing the federal constituency. As was done in past years, the committee added candidate pictures to the nominee profiles to put a face to each nominee profile. Ballots and nominee profiles were sent to the membership on May 14, 2018. Also, the committee worked with the Communications Committee to spotlight each candidate on the WVAGP Facebook page leading up to the election. Election of the new Board of Directors members will be at the annual membership meeting June 11, 2018. Members of the committee include Barbara L. MacLennan (Chair), Jennings Starcher, Jessica Brewer, Nate Davis, Ben Everette and two members who are no longer on the committee due to other commitments (Craig Neidig and Matt Mullenax). The Election Committee is actively seeking new members.

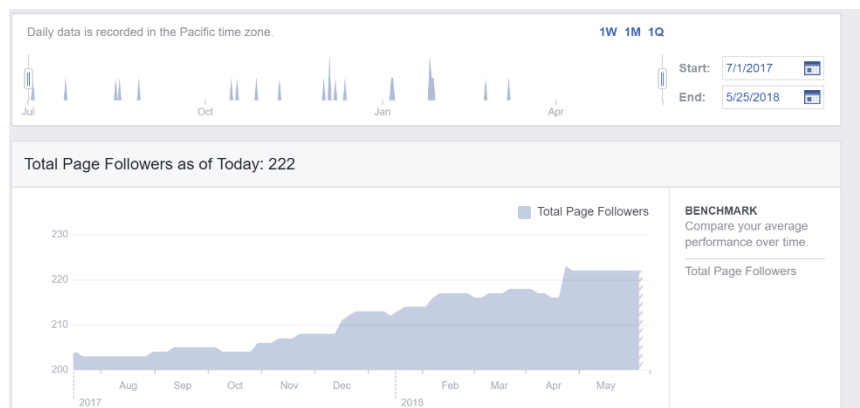

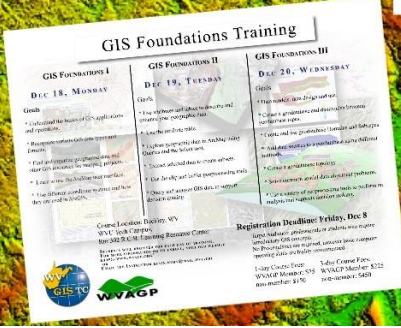

Technical Issues Committee

As a newly elected member of WVAGP Board and Chair of the Technical Issues Committee for 2017, this was my first time serving as a board member and a committee chair for any organization. Being the sole member of the Technical Issues Committee for this first year, I wanted to learn from the senior members about how the board and associated committees work.

The Technical Issues Committee worked with former Chair, Kevin Kuhn on an official submission of recommended text for the WV Society of Professional Surveyor's proposed WV Datum and Legislative Rule Changes.

The Technical Issues Committee also reached out to public and private organizations currently using unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs) for data capture to understand how other organizations might get started using this technology. The increased popularity and use of UAVs, with complex regulation, limited information/guidelines on use, and no official State organization overseeing this technology presents an important technical issue. The Technical Issues Committee is hoping to address this in the coming year with additional members and development of a sub-committee specific to UAV use for data collection.
